History and production This property is apparently a relocation of some old workings that were excavated in a search for gold and silver. The district has had a very ~~limited~~ production of gold and silver, but no antimony. *limited*

Type Deposit (Goeolgy) The veins strike north and south and dip 70° W. The veins are very tight and in a few openings minute quantities of antimony sulphide are exposed. There is no indication of continuity of the antimony along the strike or dip.

Mine Workings The veins have been explored by numerous small trenches and one 70 foot shaft on the west vein.
