GEOLOGY: A shallow shaft explores a N55W, 70SW quartz vein in pink-orthoclase granite. The vein contains moderately heavy iron-oxide gossan and spotty green oxide-copper minerals. The vein quartz is milky and mixed with gossan. No primary sulfide minerals were noted. The vein is about 25-35 cm wide in the wall of the shaft.

REMARKS: Sample 2360 is of select gossan and copper-stained quartz vein matter from the dump.
