DEVELOPMENT: Three inclines..the largest over 100 foot deep

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None but drilling in the last five years.

GEOLOGY: The three inclines are were sunk on the dip slope of a vein in sheared and altered rhyolite. At the surface the vein strikes N20°W and dips 40°W but at about 40 feet below the surface the dip slope steepens drastically. There is considerable bleaching and alteration along the contact of the vein. The vein material consist of stringers of quartz with some brecciation. Mineralization includes pyrite and wispy gray streaks of sulfides. Drilling in the general area especially along the shear has occurred in the recent past.
