DEVELOPMENT: Approximately 5 inclines, 2 adits and an equal number of prospects

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Drilling, staking, excavation of open-pit building and covering of leach pads..everything has been abandoned.

GEOLOGY: Sample 2772 was taken from dumps associated with the inclines that were sunk along a N20°W bearing shear that dips near 50°SW. The sample material consist of vuggy quartz, rhyolite breccia with iron staining a bleached white alteration. An adit further to the west and on the side of what might be a rhyolite plug may be a western extention of the same fault vein system. The adit bears S70°W, and was driven in rhyolite. Twenty feet from the portal a winze decends to the southwest at 50° following the N20°W bearing of the aforementioned workings. The vein material was a highly vuggy and altered quartz which was chipped from the vein inside the adit.
