Dear Sir:

Mr. Campbell sent me a letter asking me to forward to you any information in my possession regarding the Great Bend mine compiled by me during my recent survey.

Most of my work was based upon the report by Mr. Turner, and I had only a few assays made myself, those to check in a general way Mr. Turner's sampling of the dump. They are as follows:

From four pits, approximately three feet wide by five feet maximum vertical depth, two samples each pit, one from the crusted surface material, and one from the freshly exposed face in the pit, and near the bottom in the loose material. The four pits are on the South side of the dump, about half way up, and spaced about equally along this South face.

2nd pit	-----	"	1.40	"	29.40
3rd pit	-----	"	35.00	"	8.40
East pit	-----	"	12.80	"	36.40

As far as data is concerned, you have in your possession all the information used by me in arriving at my conclusions, i.e., the reports and assay maps of the mine and dumps.
