DEVELOPMENT: An inclined shaft about 10m deep, a trench, and 3 rotary drill holes, one of which is 40m deep (hole GLD 81-30). The drill holes were done within the last few years.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: The area is a small outcrop of dacite surrounded by alluvium. The purplish, relatively fresh Tertiary dacite is cut by a 1m wide N75W70NE silicified fault zone. There is some argillic alteration within the zone, but the walls of the zone are relatively unaltered. The drill holes were collared to intersect the zone at depth; they appear to have encountered alternating argillized and fresh dacite. This may reflect a possible second parallel fault 15m to the north; the dip of this fault could not be determined.

REMARKS: Photo A5-"14E" shows the shaft; hill in near distance has the Free Gold NO.1 claim on its right slope.
