DEVELOPMENT: Several adits and shafts totaling a few hundred meters of workings

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None; no recent development indicated.

GEOLOGY: Iron-oxide minerals are concentrated in a north-trending? fault? breccia zone in a flow-banded, light gray, spherulitic rhyolite, which is probably an intrusive into dacite which surrounds the hill to the west. The claim name suggests free gold, although no was observed. The rocks are locally silicified and argillized over a larger area.

A shallow shaft to the west of the old house near the wash explores a north-Trending high angle altered fault zone, with some iron-oxide staining.

Workings in the NE/4 SE/4 S 15, T 35, R 44E were only observed from a distance but appear to be associated with strong iron-staining that caps a small hill above the workings. This iron-stained rock appears identical to the zone observed at sample site 448.

REMARKS: Sample 448 is of iron-stained rock and gossan from the dump of an adit.

Photo A5-"14D" is of the hill with the prospects (looking post), an old house and the blazer in the foreground.
