DEVELOPMENT: Several shafts with large dumps and extensive underground workings on the
Goldfield Belmont Mine and nearby Vernal Claims.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Meridian Land and Mineral Co. has drilled several rotary holes to 50m
or more just to the northwest of the Goldfield Belmont dump. Drilling on 9 Jul 82.

GEOLOGY: The original workings were on east-west? silicified and alunited zones in Tertiary
volcanic rocks. Meridian Land and Mineral Co. is attempting to find bulk-minable
type mineralization outside these relatively narrow zones.
