

D. one thousand nine hundred and forty-five, between the COUNTY TREASURER, TRUSTEE FOR ESMERALDA COUNTY, STATE OF NEVADA, Party of the First Part, and Lewis I. Masters of the City of Tonopah, County of Nye, State of Nevada, Party of the Second Part. WITNESSETH:

THAT WHEREAS: the said second party on the 18th day of October, A. D. 1944, presented to and filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Esmeralda County, State of Nevada, an affidavit and petition showing that he is a citizen of the United States; that there is belonging to Esmeralda County, as shown by the Official Records thereof, the following patented mining claims, viz:

Saddle Rock, U. S. Survey No. 2379

situate, lying and being in the Goldfield Mining District as the same is laid down and delineated in the official map of said District on file in the office of the Recorder of Esmeralda County, State of Nevada, which have become the property of the said County through operation of the Revenue Law of the State; that the amount of the tax and penalties and costs for which the said claims became the property of said county of Esmeralda, is Eighty-one Dollars and Sixty-five Hundreds (\$81.65); that it is his bona fide intention to explore and develop said claims, not as agent for any person, company, association, partnership, firm or corporation, but solely for his own use and benefit, and

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of November, A. D. 1944, the said Board of County Commissioners, by an Order entered upon their minutes, granted said second party the right to explore the said properties, for a period of six months from the date of the said Order, and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of said Statute, the second party became thereby entitled, for the said period, to purchase the said properties, by payment as purchase price therefor, the sum for which the said properties were conveyed to the said County, and
