Subject Lena Hammond Unpatented Claims

You asked me to check on the validity of her unpatented claims lying over deeded lots. I cannot find anything that stipulates an exact footage as far as mineral rights versus surface rights.


Attached is a copy of the patent from President Taft to Judge Stevens, Trustee of the Township, as granted. I have underlined in red the pertinent part. Also attached is the Trustee's statement found on the Goldfield Trustee's map with the pertinent part underlined in red.

In Title 43 Townsites on the Public Lands it says "That no entry shall be made by such mineral-vein claimant for surface ground where the owner or occupier of the surface ground shall have had possession of the same before the inception of the title of the mineral-vein applicant."

I talked with Mr. Robert Webb of Reno and he told me that there was no specific depth involved in townsites and that the closest thing that he could come to with an opinion was that "Mines can be developed subject to reimbursement by the mine owner for any damage done to surface properties."

However, Title 43 does not stipulate what surface rights are (depth by feet) so I really don't know what her actual rights are, but I doubt highly that if she wanted to mine this property she would be allowed to. Most of her unpatented claims are located right in the center of the township and take in the Goldfield Hotel, Court House, Fire House, School, Post Office, etc.

WHEREAS, There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Carson City, Nevada, where it appears that pursuant to Sections 2387, 2388, and 2389 of the Revised Statutes of the United States, full payment has been made by Theron Stevens, Judge of the District Court in and for Esmeralda County, Nevada, for the Lots two, three, four, five, and six, the south half of the northwest quarter, the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter, and the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section two in Township three south and the Lot three and the south half of the southwest quarter of Section thirty-five in Township two south all in Range forty-two east of the Mount Diablo meridian, Nevada, containing four hundred sixty-eight and three hundredths acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

NOW KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States, unto the said Theron Stevens, the tract of land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Theron Stevens, in trust for the several use and benefit of the occupants of the Townsite of Goldfield, in said County, according to their respective interests, and to his successors in trust as aforesaid; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

as reserved for the use of the public schools— (PROVIDED that  
this dedication shall not be construed to convey any right, title  
or interest in or to any lodes, veins or deposits of mineral  
which may lie beneath the surface of the lands hereby dedicated.)



The Lena Rose No. 3 is located where the Post Office is. This claim also runs into the Bonanza unpatented claim offered by Mr. Moser of Goldfield.

The Lena Rose No. 2 covers a part of the Goldfield Hotel in Goldfield and goes Westerly for 1200 feet and also runs into the Bonanza unpatented claim offered by Mr. Moser.

The Lena Rose claim also takes in a portion of the Goldfield Hotel and goes Easterly 1150 feet covering a part of the Esmeralda County Court House.

The other claims are grouped about these claims covering other sections of the Town of Goldfield.

Observation:

From the location of the claims as above described, they would be within 1600 feet of the Columbia Fault which lies to the east as described by Mr. Martin Duffy.

There are no surface rights to these claims, only mineral rights. No depth of surface rights has been determined.

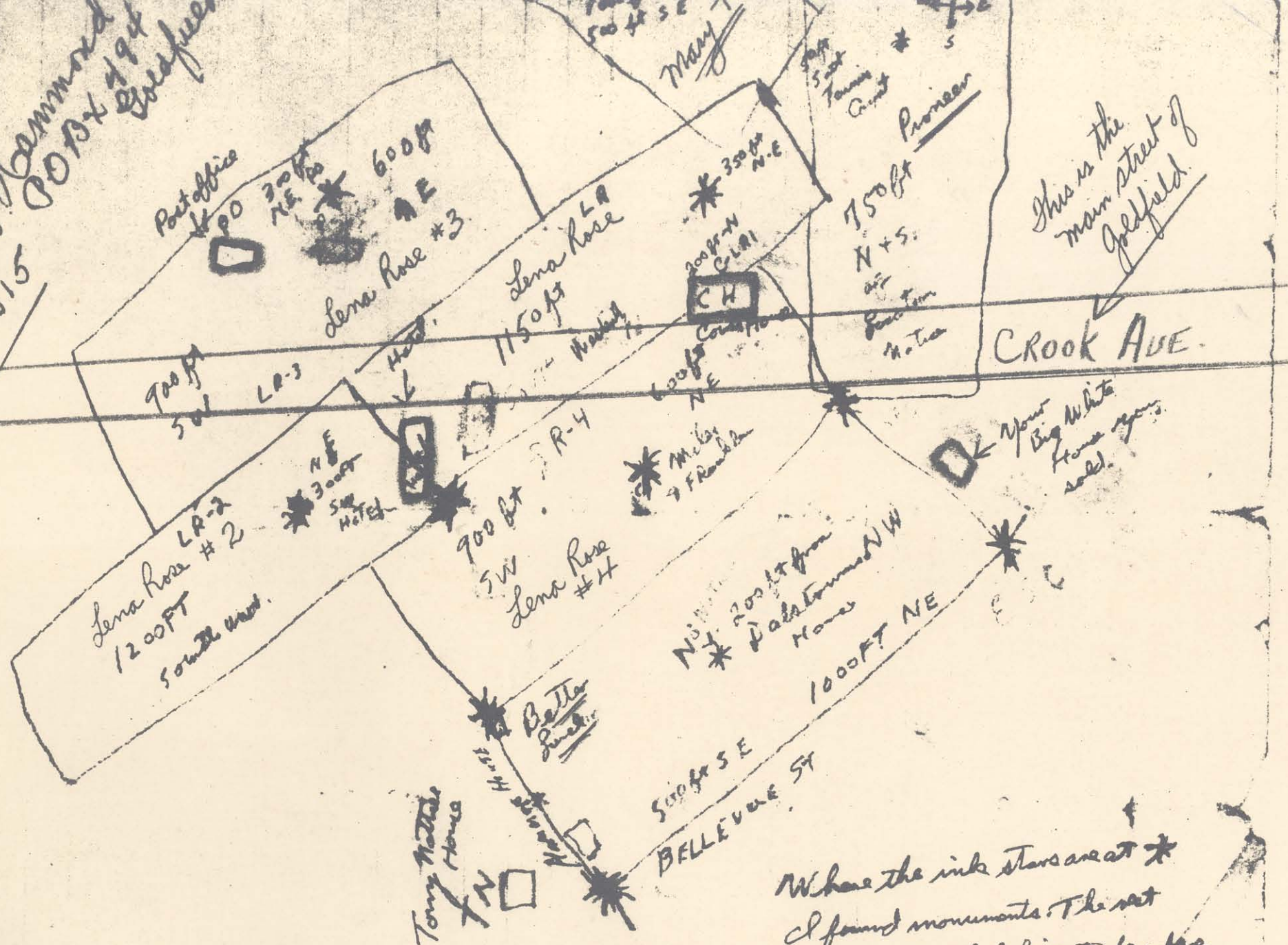
