Location:

This property is adjacent to the Town of Goldfield, Nevada, situated on the east side of the town.

Personal Property:

On the White Horse claim there are mine buildings, a hoist room and blacksmith shop.

1 - 30 HP engine (a Denver hoist)

Gallows, frame and miscellaneous equipment

400 feet of 4" aluminum pipe for air

Remarks:

The mine shaft and all equipment in good working order.

On the Columbia fault is where some of the big gold production was in the Goldfield District. The Columbia fault goes through these claims for a distance of about 2,000 feet. This area is largely unexplored and undeveloped.

Everything at this millsite is in good condition and ready for operation.

History:

This group of claims produced about \$80,000,000 in gold from 1904 to 1919. Small amounts were taken out by lessers after 1919.

Some of the underground areas in this group of claims have not been fully prospected. There are faults and fissures comming off the Columbia fault that cover both the Duffy and Davis group of claims in the lower levels that have not been prospected.

The Davis interests ask \$ 150,000<sup>00</sup> for the mining claims and personal property.

Total price for both properties \$ 325,000.<sup>00</sup>.

To develop this area properly it is needful that both the Duffy and Davis holdings be acquired.
