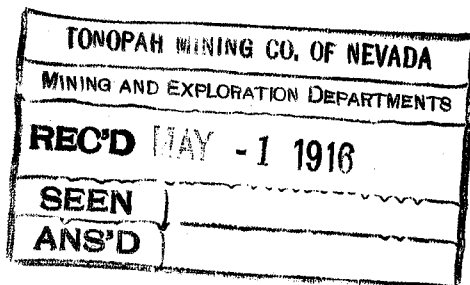

Dear Sir:
