## LOCATION

These are adjoining claims in the southern part of the Yellow Pine (Goodsprings) District, Clark County, Nevada. They may be reached by road, 8 miles, and trail, 2 miles, from Jean Station on Union Pacific Railroad.

## GEOLOGY

The area is largely limestone, closely folded and faulted. The ore occurs in a white granular limestone bed about 40 feet thick, as replacement deposits associated with intersecting fissures.

## DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

On the New Year Claim a few hundred tons of lead-zinc carbonate ore was mined during World War I. It was packed down the trail to the road junction. It was largely a surface deposit and pinched out less than 50 feet deep. No ore remains.

The Christmas, on the same vein or lode, is opened by several short tunnels in which are exposures of very low grade galena ore. The remnants of an old mill testify to the failure of attempts to extract the values. The stopes indicate a possible few hundred tons taken out.
