GEOLOGY: Workings follow NW trending, vertical to west dipping fault zone in the Mississippian Monte Cristo Formation. Country rocks very fine grained, light grey, limestone, dipping 40° west, striking north-south. Fault zone silicified and cemented with drusy quartz, abundant open spacing, very little FeOx staining, at least 2 stages of silica flooding, below mine the limestone breccia outcrops and is cemented with calcite. There appears to be at least 1000 feet of underground workings. Additional tailing down drainage
