ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: ~ None.

GEOLOGY: Cemented breccia along faults in silicified dolomite shear zone N-S, about 85°W dip and N50°-60°E, dip 45°-50°SE. Calcite and possibly calomine coat breccia fragments. Dolomite host rock is laced with white calcite veinlets near the stope area, away from structures, is grey. White quartzite seen on lower dump.

REMARKS: Description of mine in NBMG Bull 62 stresses copper production there are no traces of copper minerals on dump (?) - only oxidized zinc minerals.
