GEOLOGY: Workings single adit, S35E trending, following a vertical shear zone approximately 3 feet wide, in limestone/dolomite (Monte Cristo Limestone, Mississippian). The dump is composed of massive and brecciated, locally silicified carbonates. Rocks are cemented with calcite and chalcedonic silica carrying pods of galena, altering to anglesite, and oxidized pyrite and hematite.
