GEOLOGY: Quartz vein, 12- to 18-inches thick, cuts shaley member of quartzite unit. The vein strikes N-S to N30E, dips 40 to 55 degrees west; the quartzite formation strikes N10E to N10W, dips 40 to 50 degrees to the east. The vein occupies a reverse fault, is brecciated by the fault. Chlorite occurs on both walls of the vein; vein is locally stained by iron and manganese oxides. Galena and pyrite are present in the vein quartz.

REMARKS: Workings expose the vein system for about 800 feet along strike; this system is parallel to but several hundred feet west of the vein exposed on the Kahama claims to the south.
