DEVELOPMENT: Inclined shaft, flooded about 30' below collar. Adit below shaft crosscuts to vein structure.

GEOLOGY: Two foot wide quartz vein in quartzite, vein strikes N7OE, dips 70-75 degrees to the northwest, another parallel vein crops out about 20'SE. The quartzite wall rock strikes N-S, dips 45 degrees SE. The vein contains tetrahedrite, galena; green and blue copper oxide minerals stain the outcrops.

REMARKS: Small ore pile at cabin site below the shaft, ore was carried down canyon to north.

The size of the dump at the shaft collar suggests that there may be 200-300 feet of underground workings extending from the shaft.
