DEVELOPMENT: Cuts and short adit on outcrop, up slope from main adit; main adit 270 long, about 60 feet of drift along vein from end of adit.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Reddish, iron-oxide stained quartz vein crops out in N7OE, 55 degree NW structure cutting quartzite, wall rock is kaolinized, gouge along vein walls, some brecciation in vein. Possibly same vein as exposed at sample site 3029.

REMARKS: Adit bears \$40E for 270 feet, intersects vein, drift along vein about 50-60 feet long. A tram line extended from the outcrop workings down to the adit level; ore was lowered to the adit level where it could then be loaded onto trucks. The wire, drum, and tram poles are still present, but are scattered along the slope below the mine workings.
