ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Recent staking in the area.

GEOLOGY: The old shaft is on a N15°E structure near the side of a large rhyolite plug. The structure maybe 4-5 feet wide but has very little quartz although a broad range of silicified material including some breccia is present in the dump. The host rhyolite is altered and bleached particularly within and along the margin of the shear zone. Silicified material comprise most of Sample 3082 with some breccia and pyrite mineralization.
