DEVELOPMENT: Trench and pit. Small dump.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: A 20-50 cm wide quartz vein cuts phyllite and quartzite of the Ordovician Valmy Formation. The vein trends due N, 80E. The wallrock may be somewhat silicified, but no alteration is obvious. Pyrite, chalcopyrite, limonite, malachite and rare azurite were noted.

REMARKS: Sample 2325 is grab and select vein matter from the dump. Photo LG 842-17 is of the quartz vein in the wall of the pit.
