DEVELOPMENT: An adit with stope above (25m long) and a shaft at the end of the stope. Small building.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Skarn minerals (red garnet, epidote, diopside?, quartz) occur along a 1m wide zone between light gray quartz monzonite and light gray marble. Some white ("bull") quartz is present in the zone. Minor pyrite was noted. The contact trends due N, 80E. The adjacent limestone has an attitude of N30E, 80SW.

REMARKS: Sample 1586 is of quartz vein matter and garnet-epidote skarn with sparse pyrite.
