GEOLOGY: Parallel quartz veins in granodiorite bearing S50°W and dipping 50°SE. The vein are up to 14 inches wide with gouge or solid mineral of arsenopyrite on the footwall. Workings are old and have been partly bulldozed. Sample 2849 was cut from the quartz vein in the main adit. Sample 2850 was mostly arsenopyrite from the vein and gouge zone. Very little prospecting has been done considering the history of the mineralization.
