DEVELOPMENT: Adit, winze inside, cuts & open stopes upslope to NE.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Mine developed along N10°- 50°E vertical fracture zone in limestone, quartz-calcite vein developed along zone, clots of red-brown and yellow-brown gossan in vein. Gossan areas, with jasperoid, are 2'-6'wide along structure. White quartz-gossan contains clots of galena rimmed with anglesite. Ore zones appear to have been chutes and chimneys which formed within the major N10°-50°E structure, all are near vertical. Limestone host rock strike N10°E, dips 25°NW, is moderately bleached near the mineralized structures.
