GEOLOGY: Currently being drilled by Boyles Drilling out of Salt Lake City. Head driller, (Goldfield?) met us and asked us very tersely to leave. We were able to grab a random sample from the dumps along the side of the road. Brecciated quartzite, pyrite ghosts. FeOx limonite-Mn stained, fractured. Some of sample heavy possibly barite. Heavily FeOx stained, free-flowing water, several vertical shafts in area, at least 1000 feet of workings, fenced. New drill roads dozed. Looks like some of old dump being milled for residual minerals.
