PRESENT AND POTENTIAL ORE RESERVES

Work at this property was discontinued in September 1943. At that time it was thought that possibly not to exceed 5,000 tons of ore averaging about .6% WO3 was available (this proved to be a generous estimate). Since operations of lessees ceased, advices have been received that the owners shipped approximately 1,000 tons of ore averaging around .5% WO3 - although we have no substantiating evidence of this.
