DEVELOPMENT: 1 Shaft \approx 20' deep with wooden headframe.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Area is staked with PVC pipe marked FB claims. A drill road & hole are located just to NW of shaft.

GEOLOGY: Red resistant outcrop of jasperoid runs along base of range. All the way from sample loc. 883 to here. The jasperoid rib strikes \approx N10-30E.

Shaft explores jasperoid with resistant outcrop just E of working. Limestone beds crop out above jasperoid on ridge top to E. Jasperoid body appears to cut across bedding of limestone but may just be a result of shearing. Slicks on jasperoid indicates possible silicified movement of body.

Most rock on dump is silicified limestone & gossan with abundant hematite & limonite staining. One large brecciated boulder also found on dump. The breccia contains frags. of silicified limestone (frags 3" & less) cemented by glassy blue to dark green amorphous mineral. Tiny fleck of chrysocolla also found on dump.

REMARKS: Sample 884- Gossany jasperoid breccia
885- Jasperoid breccia with blue glassy, amorphous mineral cementing fragments.
