North 4 3 9 2 1 1 0 0 mEast 0 6 7 2 2 7 0 mZone +11DEVELOPMENT: Partially caved shaft ~ 20-30' deep (?) with timbered frame around collar.ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, other than staking in area but some old old flagging in area.GEOLOGY: Shaft is sunk in black to brown silty shales(pilot Fm?) just W of a resistant ridge of jasperoid breccia. The shales are oxidized (limonitic) on weathered surface & have calcite coatings & Mn dendrits on partings.30' E of shaft is red colored jasperoid breccia containing silicified clasts of grey limestone. The jasperoid body strikes ~ N-S and continues across small drainage North of shaft. Jasperoid outcrop shows abundant slickensides.Jasperoid was sampled from dump, as shales did not appear mineralized. Most of dump consisted of shale, with minor amount of unsilicified grey limestone with calcite veinlets. Small rounded siliceous concretions also found on dump. They probably weathered out of shales.Small prospect in limestone SE of shaft.Dumb- next time we get shale sample too! (Dissem. Au!)REMARKS: Sample 883- Jasperoid & gossan.
