ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Quartz veins in Prida Limestone a few meters above contact with Koipato rhyolite. Veins N40-50 E dip 45° SE some veinlets at right angles to this trend. Veins a few cm wide. Mineralogy quartz, muscovite, tourmaline, scheelite, beryl, pyrite, Fluorite. Veins parallel to contact between Prida & Koipato.

Lakeview geology essentially identical to Starlight open pit area. Same position & mineralogy.
