DEVELOPMENT: Several pits in gravels numerous prospect cuts and trenches.ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Active placer, truck haulage from gravel pits front end loader, trommels, sluice, jigs.

GEOLOGY: Placer gold, cinnabar & scheelite occur in Quaternary gravels in and adjacent to Imlay Canyon. Most productive gravel is Holocene 1-2m thick which rests on older gravels which are locally FeOx stained & cemented by caliche to varying degrees. Gravels rest on phyllite of Grass Valley Formation. Older gravels contain some gold, but generally not enough to pay for mining. Inspiration Copper conducted exploration in district in 1984 but returned property to owner as being too small.

Best values occur in thin youngest gravels which are unconsolidated and moderately well sorted and overly older, poorly sorted, semi-indurated gravels
