GEOLOGY: The barite occurs with chert & claystone of the Ordovician Valmy Fm.
Barite & rock exposures are poor, but a barite unit, exposed at the head of
N-S gully is about 1' thick, & strikes N50W, 55-90° SW. The unit is traceable for 25'
along strike. The cherts are locally altered to sericite & are Fe-stained.
Barite was probably mined from a dip slope on the east side of the gully.
The barite is grey, very fine-grained, fetid, locally bleached & cut by vugs &
veinlets of white barite. It contains small amounts of quartz, mica & FeOxs.
