LOCATION:

This property is situated three miles south of Unionville. Pershing County, Nevada. And 23 miles south of Inlay. On the Southern Pacific Railway, and in what is known as the Indian Mining District.

PROPERTY:

The property is owned by the Manoa Mining Company, A Nevada Corporation and includes eight claims, known as the Saturn, Jupiter, Ingersoll, Starlight, Water Lily, Mermaid, Amended Fraction "A", and Amended Fraction "B", consisting of an acreage of 129.278 acres. (see map) The claims are located in such a such a manner as to fully protect the company against any future location so adverse claimants on adjoining holdings,. The title is perfect, a United States Mineral Patent covers all of the eight claims.

DEVELOPMENT.

The property has been extensively developed and prospected by open cuts, drifts and tunnels. The three principle workings are represented by three levels consisting of over 5,000 feet tunnelling and the ground prospected by numerous drifts and cross-cuts exposing fine ore.

GEOLOGY:

The main formation of the district in which the Manoa Claims are located is Rhyolite. The lode is 538 feet wide, rhyolite east or foot-wall and conglomerate west of hanging-wall.

The pitch of the lode is 45 degrees to the west.

The principle workings lie along side of a basalt dike, which is the main geological feature of economic importance. The ground is traversed by a north and south vein, this being the principle vein, other veins act generally as feeders, much of the ore has formed in contact or in the neighborhood of the basalt dike. Toward the southern end of the property, on the south end line of the Starlight Claim, extensive prospecting has been done along the contact of an intrusion of andesite.

The lode in its entirety is well mineralized from wall to wall, the gangue is a porphyry quartz and carries gold, silver, copper and lead values, which range from a few dollars to several hundred dollars per ton.

IMPROVEMENTS:

The improvements include a Boarding House. Bunk-house, Office, Blacksmith shop, Powder-house and Store-house.

WATER:

A creek passing through the property carries sufficient water nearly all year round for general purposes.

The mine makes about 5 miners inches of excellent water continuously without any variation.

The water for domestic purposes in the buildings is piped from a spring on the mountain side nearby, pure and of continuous flow the year round.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Elevation about 5,000 feet above sea-level

Good roads from railway to mine.

Light snow-fall in winter, but the property can be worked the entire year,.

Maps, original assay certificates, ore and smelter returns can be seen at our office.

Sufficient work has been done to prove that the property contains a very extensive ore-body and with further work it should develop into a large producer.

The Nevada Valleys Power Company, Lovelock, Nevada, is now furnishing the electric power to the mines in the Rochester District, this power could be brought to this property, a distance of about 9 miles.
