GEOLOGY

The rock formation is described by the Federal Geological Survey as chert and shale. The area is fractured by numerous faults, cross-faults, or fissures, and it is at the intersection of these, with the thin bedded cherts, that the manganese occurs.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The deposits are small, irregularly shaped masses in which ore containing 35 or more per cent of manganese is a minor quantity. A few shallow surface cuts comprise the development. The ore has a high silica content and is inaccessible without considerable road construction.
