Dear Mr. Barringer:

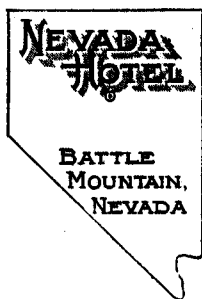
