GEOLOGY: An argillized and slightly silicified zone in the Tertiary underdown tuff (rhyolite ash-flow tuff) (Bonham, 1970) has been prospected. The altered zone is believed to be a N40E, 70SE?? gouge and crush zone about 75cm wide. However, the adit begins in this zone and cuts across? it at 90°. Minor iron-staining present. The prospect is not strongly mineralized; possibly geochemistry would suggest the elements sought.
