DEVELOPMENT: Several short adits are present in the SW/4 S36. Only those in C, SW/4 S36 were examined. No adits are probably over 50m?

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None except recent surveying, probably by Minerals Management, Fish Lake Valley, NV.

GEOLOGY: A sparse amount of white vein quartz was observed on small dumps. The trend of the vein could not be determined. A small pit near the top of the hill in the exact C, SW/4, S36, has copper oxides minerals (chrysocolla, copper pitch) along fractures in pre-Tertiary meta-andesite. The small pit is along the east side of a north-trending silicified and iron-stained zone in the meta-andesite. The zone is 4-5 m wide. Sample 409 is of this copper mineralization which does not particularly resemble most of the quartz vein-related mineralization in the district.

The adit nearest the center of S36 on the topo map (Sample locality 410) contains pyrite quartz and siderite? in alternating quartz-rich and pyrite-rich bands. Wallrock is brown and iron-stained, possibly related to a pyritic alteration halo around veins. These brownish altered zones in normally green meta-andesite might be useful exploration guides. A small piece of brownish wallrock is included in sample 410. The workings at 410 could be the War Eagle, but they are probably \leq 50 m and hardly seen extensive enough to have had production. There is no road to them. The vein may be N60E, 25? SE.

REMARKS: This property is in the vicinity of either the War Eagle or Last Chance Mines, but does not have workings enough to be either. The names of the Particular mines, as inferred from published sources, is very unactive. Sample 409 near top of ridge, sample 410 on dump of adit northside of ridge.
