GEOLOGY: See Garside (1973). No new information from this visit.

REMARKS: Photo # 16 taken of small pit and dump. Sample 405 from dump. The use of the name Idlewild in parentheses after Hazel E by the New location suggest the possibility that the Idlewild uranium prospect which could not be located in 1969 (Garside, 1973), may be the same as the Hazel E, the geologic descriptions are rather different, however.
