Sir:

We have filled out a form we got from the Elko Independent newspaper office. We enclose it herewith and two maps, one map of the central part of the Jarbidge Mining District, indicating the veins developed or partly developed.

The second map shows very clearly our Ben Hur-Reward group. The elevations above sea level indicate what depths may be obtained in developing our group.

The water for mill purposes northeast of our group is at the south end of Finance No 8 lode claim, and 200 feet lower in elevation is a mill site equally as good, but farther away.

Our mining district has produced fully \$7,000,000 since milling the ore started, principally by the Elko Mines Co.

Wherever we have opened our veins we have obtained free gold by panning.

Note that we have THREE fissure veins running thru our claims from end to end or more than 3,000 feet.

A mill on the Jarbidge River will afford the greatest opportunity for deep mining and ample drainage.

We believe that our group will justify a large outlay in purchase and development.
