DEVELOPMENT: Adit low on east slope of hill, caved but water seeping from opening, upper portal and small stope open, remains of air pipe ore chute between upper and lower dumps.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: N55° E, near vertical, shear zone in shaley argillite, zone 2'-3' wide, dark, cinn-brown gossan lenses, 6"-8" wide, on both walls, central portion brecciated wall rock with gossan clots. Bedding approx. N5°W, 60°W dip but folded & rolls into syncline at upper portal. Shear zone can be traced, on surface by alteration, to southwest for at least 1000'. Zone has recently been drilled, cuttings piles remain on drill road cut on slope to the southwest of the upper portal.

Oxidized vein material on dump, gossan with cerrussite, galena, sphalerite, pyrite.
