GEOLOGY: Structure not discernable, pits along N40W trend, may follow shear zone, wall rock limey shale and quartzite. Rock in pits highly altered, volcanic rocks cap the ridge north and south of the prospect. Rock on the dumps laced with white quartz veinlets, some yellow oxide staining, some fine-grained black sulfide mineral-possibly stibnite in the quartz.

REMARKS: Old rock cabin foundation found down canyon from the prospect, square nail and fragments of purple glass indicate that these are old workings. No evidence of work here for 6-10 years.
