GEOLOGY: Adit and shafts expose two parallel quartz veins cutting quartzite and phyllite. The veins trend N10E, dip 50-70NW, and contain clots and points of cinn-brown gossan. The lower (adit) vein is about 2' thick, contains some cerrussite. Vein material on the upper dumps is more gossany, has some pyrite staining. The vein structures can be traced for about 400 feet to the north by outcroppings on the canyon walls.
