GEOLOGY: A series of N-W trending prospect pits in metamorphosed shales of the Gold Hill Formation. Narrow iron stained quartz veins are exposed in a series of hand dug prospects along the southside of Broad Creek. The veins are thought to be occupying shears in the sediments. Some older staking is still in tact but no new work is in evidence. Sample 2026 was selected from several of the pits. Assays revealed very low values for all elements sampled.
