DEVELOPMENT: Several adits, inclined shafts, drill roads, minor exploration in vicinity, remains of house & heavy equipment.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Workings in P6 Stirling Quartzite (purplish-red, micaceous silty-sandy lenses, bleached SS, fine to medium, round to sub-rounded grains, no apparent bedding planes at site). Main workings on SSW facing ridge, sample taken from approx. 200 feet, N25E, 75° inclined shaft following 1 to 3 foot wide quartz vein/shear zone with specularite cementing the gouge material. At the sample site the quartzite was thinly bedded, S25W, 30° Crystalline barite occurred intergrown with the specularite. Minor copper staining appeared in upper workings.
