GEOLOGY: The sample site is a series of vertical and inclined shafts, adits, and trenches on a NE facing ridge of the Cambrian Johnnie Formation. The workings total less than 200 feet with no activity in at least 50 years. The pinkish-grey banded quartzite with exposed surfaces coated with manganese oxide was cut with stringers and massive veins of sulfide-bearing quartz. The veins were highly fractured and iron stained from the oxidized pyrite. Below the workings were the remains of an old cabin.
