The Fink-Mahony Mining and Milling Company is located in the West Comstock Mining District at Jumbo, Ormsby County, Nevada. The property is six miles by road from Washoe on the Virginia City and Truckee Railroad, and about three miles west from Virginia City.

There are three veins or zones of altered and silicified rhyolite. The vein which has been developed is about three feet in width. It has been stope to a depth of about 100 feet and for a length of from 150 to 200 feet. The vein strikes N 5 E, dips 66 to the West, and varies in width from 1' to 5'.

There is a 5-Stamp mill with a No. 2 Dodge Crusher and a 4'x12' amalgamating table. This equipment has not been used very much.

The property is owned by M.B. Greene of Reno, and the price asked is \$25,000.
