

GOLD REED PROPERTY

LOCATION On east slope of Kawich Mountains, about 35 miles south of Reveille.

HISTORY Before 1900 a large amount of shallow development was done on this property in the form of shafts and trenches.

GEOLOGY Country rock is chiefly an iron-stained quartzite covered in part by small patches of a lava mud flow.

The quartzite has been subject to hot water action, giving it a well mineralized appearance but no ore had been found yet.

At one place there is a small gossan showing but no copper stain.

CONCLUSIONS There has already been a large amount of development work done on the property that has exposed no ore, which makes the possibility of finding ore improbable.
