GEOLOGY: A white bull quartz vein, about 15 cm wide, cuts foliated, quartz-eye granitic rock. The vein matter contains clots of sericite and sparse limonite. No economic minerals were noted. The granite is probably part of the Triassic leucogranite (see Johnson, 1977).
