GEOLOGY: Massive, banded quartz vein in phyllite, quartz stringers in wallrock parallel to main vein. Zone 10' wide with 3' of quartz on each side of "horse" of phyllite, vein vuggy, with clear, euhedral quartz crystals, spots tetrahedrite, pyrite, green CuOx stains, vein strikes E-W to N70°E, is vertical, thins along strike, vein walls show slicksides, vein has wall rock inclusions. Galena, amber sphalerite, chalcopyrite present, also in vein material from upper dump. Specks scheelite seen in one rock from sample 346

REMARKS: Main stoper area 100' long, 30' down dip, 5' wide on vein, most work appears 1930's vintage, but timbers with square nails indicate some work may date back to 1870's. Cabin on Blakeley Creek, old mine & bios there are 1930-40 - age. Trail from Blakely Cr. to mine is fairly wide, even grade, indicating was improved for auto travel at one time. Two patented claims Golden Star & Grand Deposit. M.S. 3426, patented Dec. 1907.
