Browne, J. R., Mineral resources of the states and territories west of the Rocky Mountains for 1867, pp. 411-412.

The Kinsley district, (considered Lander County in 1867) is distinguished for its massive lodes of copper-bearing ore. It is in the Antelope range of mountains, 45 miles NE of Egan. The lodes are large, and ore is represented as being upon the surface which shows by assay from 35-50% of copper and from \$60-\$100 per ton in silver.
