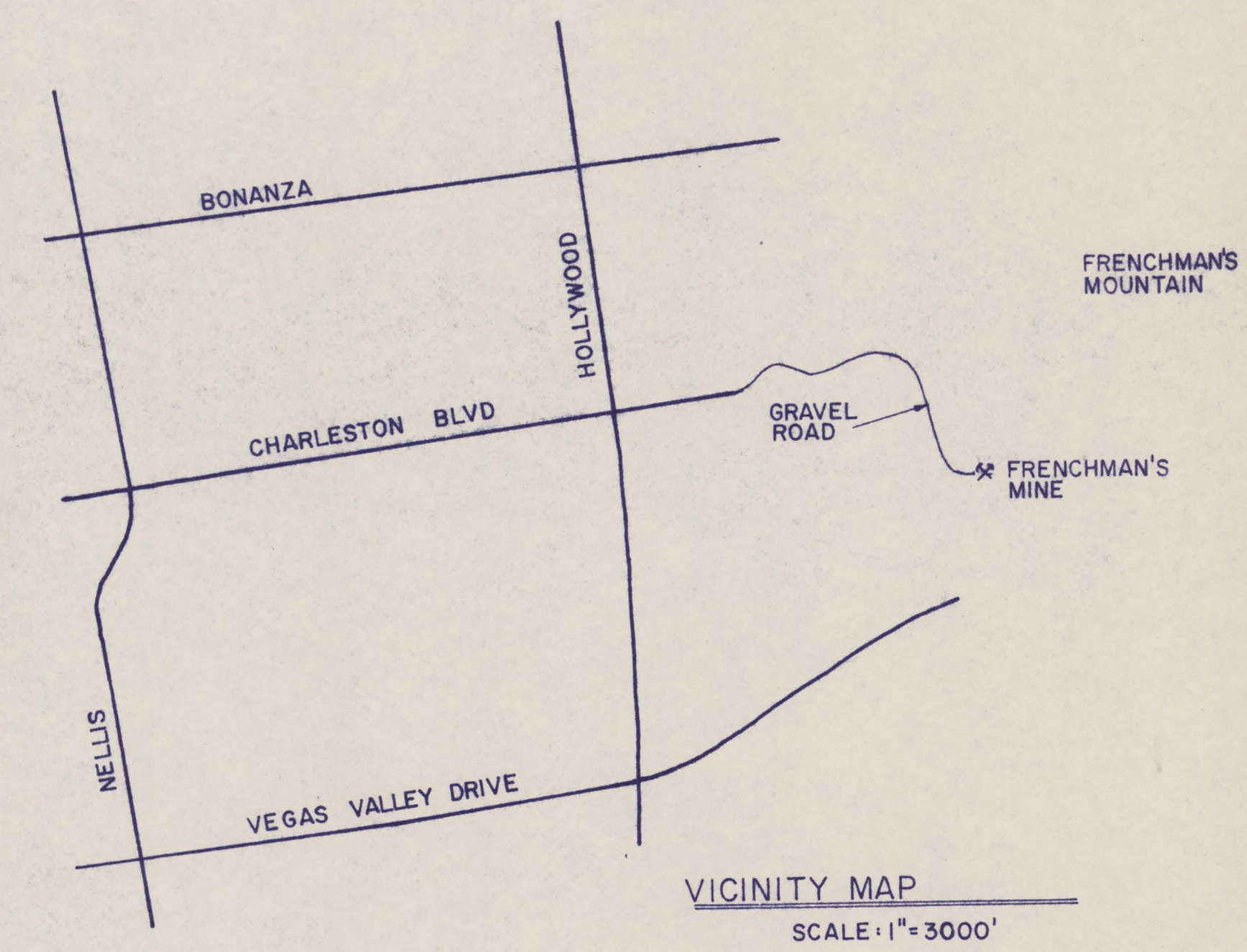


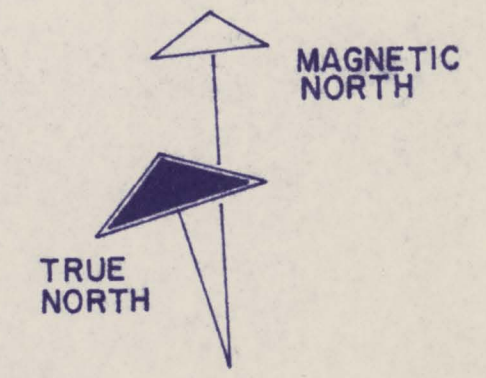
PLAN OF SHELTER AREA

- NOTES
1. MAIN ENTRY HAS BEEN CLOSED. CONDITION OF VENT ON EAST SIDE OF MOUNTAIN IS UNKNOWN BUT SHAFT IS NEAR VERTICAL AND INACCESSIBLE.
 2. EXACT LOCATION OF VERTICAL SHAFT NOT KNOWN - THE ROOM IS SAID TO BE LARGE.
 3. WITH THE OPENING OF THE MINE VENTILATION WOULD BE GOOD. IT WOULD SERVE THE NEARBY RESIDENTIAL AREA OF EAST CHARLESTON WITH A 5-10 MINUTE DRIVE TO THE MINE.
 4. PARKING COULD BE ACCOMMODATED WITHIN A SHORT WALKING DISTANCE WITH SOME GRADING WORK.
 5. THE INFORMATION IS APPROXIMATE AND WAS TAKEN FROM A CLAIM PLOT DATED OCTOBER 18, 1913.
